Thank you for your letter of 22 April. Please forgive me the delay in replying. It has been a busy period.

I did not have enough copies of the project description to serve all the member organizations of the Board, but by sharing what we had everyone could become better acquainted with the substance of the project.

I have been asked to transmit to you the Board's congratulations for having worked out the proposals on behalf of the NGO Conference and for obtaining the handsome grant to finance the project.

In view of the fact that the NGO Conference will have the "legal" responsibility for the project, the Board agreed that procedures should be worked out for consultation, reporting and financial accounting. The treasurer of the NGO Conference will write you about this in due course.

It was proposed that the NGO ad hoc and sub-committees in New York and Geneva concerned with the status of women should appoint five or six organizations which would work with you and which would be entrusted with supervising the project on behalf of the NGO Conference.

I am sure you will have ideas on the above and I would be glad to know about them.
