In reference to your March 30th inquiry about "IWY program Crimes Against Women", there was a meeting in Mexico at the IWY Tribune on this topic, but no record was made, in keeping with Tribune practise.

However, a "Tribunal on Crimes Against Women" was held on March 4-8, 1976, in Brussels. A report on this Conference appeared in the Winter 1976 issue (Vol. 2, Number 2) of Signs: Journal of Women in Culture and Society, p.p. 478-482, which you may be able to obtain at your library.

One of the action proposals presented at the Tribunal which has now taken concrete form is the publication of an international feminist newsletter known as ISIS (Women's International Information and Communication Service). For further information regarding this newsletter, you can write:
