MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE POST-TRIAL SUBMISSIONS

Defendant Price Waterhouse hereby moves for a seven-day extension of time for filing its proposed findings, proposed decree and supporting brief until April 20, 1990. Such an extension is necessary due to the need to examine the record in this case and respond fully to the arguments of counsel to plaintiff and to unavoidable conflicts in the commitments of counsel.
