Preliminary Program

All Tribune sessions and registration will take place at the National Medical Center, (Unidad. de Congresos, Centro Medico) Avenida Cuauhtemoc 330, Mexico City.

Formal registration will begin Tuesday, June 17 at 9:00 and will continue from 9:00 - 18:00 every day thereafter.

Each morning from 9:00 - 10:00 beginning June 20, there will be a briefing on the United Nations Conference for Tribune participants.

Morning sessions begin at 10:00 and end at 13:00. Afternoon sessions begin at 15:00 and end at 18:00. Two concurrent sessions are scheduled each morning and afternoon.

Simultaneous interpretation in Spanish, French and English will be available for all the sessions listed in this program.

The officially scheduled sessions of the Tribune are being developed through a format of panel discussions and case studies to reflect current programs and personal views on the issues. The panels are organized to provide an intellectual framework within which action programs could be designed, and are related to case studies to give examples of practical, action approaches.

Speakers will be listed in the final program to be distributed at registration.

In addition to the sessions listed here, (through June 27), sessions will be planned in Mexico for June 30 - July 2. Persons wishing to make suggestions for the sessions to be held during these closing days should ask for appropriate forms at the time of registration in Mexico City.

Groups may request use of non-interpreted rooms at the National Medical Center for additional meetings. Procedures for making such requests will be available from the Tribune Administrative Office at the Medical Center beginning June 17.
